# Crescendo Ladino Clover

Crescendo is an upright clover with a high density of fine stems that support large, dark green leaves. Active stolon growth in the spring results in early productivity and fills in the gaps where grasses and other legumes fail. It is adapted to all of the United States, but is especially well adapted to the transition states (MO, KY, TN, MD, VA) and southeastern U.S.

- Early maturing
- Good yield potential, especially when over-seeded into established pastures
- Produces fall forage better than other varieties
- Demonstrated freedom from leaf diseases and virus pressure
- High dry matter, high starch and ME yields
- May overmature if not harvested early
